We attach great importance to exchanges between peers and to the transfer of know-how between public policy practitioners, in all the sectors and geographical areas of development cooperation.

 also help create education policies, national social-protection


systems, and pathways to social and workforce integration.


MOBILISING THE BEST EXPERTS

DEPLOYING TAILOR-MADE STRATEGIES


- Our diversified, innovative methods can adapt effectively to local and regional contexts.

Strengthening democratic, economic, and financial governance

GOVERNMENT REFORM, RULE OF LAW AND DEMOCRACY, MIGRATION

Promoting justice, human rights and democratic pluralism; addressing all aspects of international migration; strengthening public policy management; supporting decentralisation and devolution processes.

- Since 2013, Expertise France has been supporting the reform of Greece's central administration, in order to increase its operational efficiency.
- ⇒ Since 2017, the agency is involved in EUROsociAL+, a regional programme aimed at increasing the level of social cohesion in Latin America, and is responsible for its Gender component.
- (a) In North Africa, Expertise France assists institutions in charge of designing and implementing national migratory policies.

ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL GOVERNANCE

Ensuring the fair collection and efficient use of tax receipts, along with proper allocation and management of public resources; creating a favourable climate for business; facilitating regional and economic integration; strengthening national and regional statistical systems.

- (a) Expertise France currently assists Haiti with tax administration reform.
- (a) Leading European implementing agency for regional statistical cooperation programmes, Expertise France has been conducting the Pan African Statistics Programme since early 2016.
- As the main manager for EU institutional twinning projects, Expertise France coordinates many twinning projects for example on fiscal management in Morocco or on the introduction of a land register in Algeria.

Anticipating risks, managing crises, and stabilising fragile countries

Supporting countries in transition and directly assisting crisis-affected populations; strengthening governments against transregional threats, such as terrorism and organised crime; preventing nuclear, radioactive, biological, and chemical risks; bolstering civil protection services.

- ⇒ Since 2016, Expertise France implements a pilot project for the redeployment of decentralised services, enhancement of social cohesion and socio-economic recovery in 2 regions of CAR.
- (a) In Côte d'Ivoire, the agency contributes to strengthening and structuring the new corps of civil firefighters.
- ⇒ Since 2017, Expertise France coordinates CT MENA, a European project supporting the operationalisation of the EU-MENA strategic dialogue, with a focus on regional cooperation on counterterrorism.



Supporting national and local low-carbon energy strategy design and implementation; working in critical sectors — urban development, energy, agriculture, and natural resource management.

- ⇒ Since late 2016, Expertise France is one of the implementing agencies of EUROCLIMA+, a regional EU programme which assists 18 Latin American and Caribbean countries in attenuating climate change and adapting to its effects.
- → Since 2015, Expertise France has been supporting the Kingdom of Bahrain in planning and policy design for urban and territorial land-use.
- (a) In Lebanon, since 2016, Expertise France implements the Private Sector Development Programme. Funded by the EU, it aims at contributing to Lebanon's economic development and job creation by enhancing the competitiveness of the private sector, with a focus



PUBLIC HEALTH

Strengthening national health systems; responding to critical health challenges; fighting pandemics, primarily through Global Fund to Fight AIDS. Tuberculosis and Malaria initiatives.

- → In Guinea, from 2015 to 2017, the PREPARE project supported the setting up and deployment of 8 regional alert-and-response teams (ERARE), thus allowing the country to be better prepared against epidemic risks.
- ⇒ Since 2016, Expertise France has been contributing to a regional hospital construction project in Gafsa, Tunisia.
- Since 2011, Expertise France has been implementing the 5% Initiative, which assists partner countries in the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of projects funded by the Global Fund.

HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Creating social protection systems; developing collective pension systems; promoting social services and outreach policies; designing and guiding national employment, education, and workforce integration policies; expanding vocational and professional training.

- (a) Since 2017, Expertise France implements the RETFOP project, which strengthens secondary technical education and vocational and professional training in Angola.



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
