Reliable statistics allow for better governance as they are key elements for the identification, formulation and monitoring of policies. The increasing demand for robust statistics information is a central issue for statistical agencies all over the world. They are expected to be the guardians of good quality and harmonised data.

Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals is a challenging issue for the statistics community and particularly for official statistics. Objective 17 commits countries to “enhance statistical capacity-building support to developing countries to increase significantly the availability of high-quality, timely and reliable disaggregated data”.

Expertise France provides technical assistance to partner countries and regional organisations in order to improve the capacity of their national statistics institutes, to collect updated, timely relevant and high-quality data. This is crucial for political decision-making and good governance.

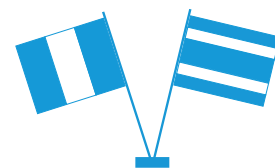

Pan African Statistics Programme - Supporting African integration by increasing access to statistical information

2016-2019 – €6.9M (EU)

Improving the production and dissemination of good quality statistics in Africa and supporting the African Union (AU) in strengthening its institutional capacity, in order to provide comparable official statistics needed to underpin the AU integration process and measure African progress towards global goals. The beneficiaries are the 55 countries members of the AU.



Medstat IV - Improving statistical capacity of Mediterranean partner countries

2016-2019 – €4.7M (EU)

Improving the statistical capacity of the national statistics institutes in order to collect updated, timely, relevant and high-quality data, necessary for political decision-making and good governance. It is also about promoting the further harmonization of statistical data in line with European and international standards. Beneficiaries include Algeria, Egypte, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine and Tunisia.



EU-ASEAN Compass - Capacity building project monitoring integration progress and statistics

2016-2020 – €6M (EU)

Increasing capacity for implementing and monitoring a continuously growing economic integration as well as producing statistical evidence to build integration policies. The beneficiaries are the 10 countries members of the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN): Brunei, Indonesia, Cambodia, Laos PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam.
